To reserve a date we need a down payment of 50% of the daily rate. The rest is due 60 days before arrival in Cameroon. Trophy fees are paid in cash before departure or via bank transfer.

THE AREA:

The hunting area is located next to the Bénoué National Park and going along the Bénoué river. However, the area is surrounded and well provided of water thanks to three other rivers bordering the hunting concession. This condition makes the area to keep fresh vegetation all year round, which is very important in order to keep the game in the area.

The two blocks that sets our concession sum around 250.000 hectares where all the species are well represented, so you will have nice opportunities to complete your quota during your safari. In fact, according to our management politics one of the areas never completed the quota given by the Government, harvesting only about 5 buffalos a year and 6/7 Lord Derby Elands a year from the possible 10. In this way, we kept a very low hunting pressure for the years letting the bulls getting older. The second block has not been hunted for the last 3 years holding now a large population.
